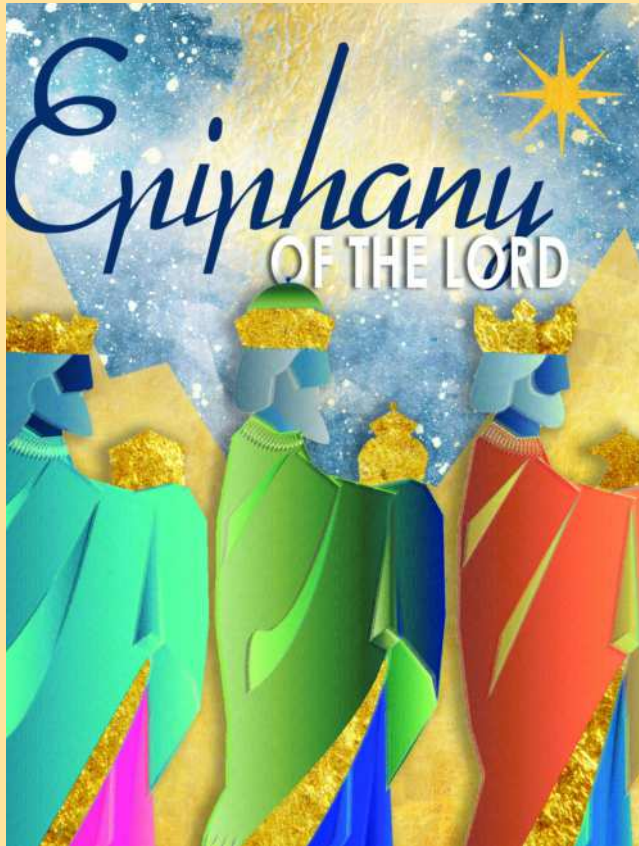

**Confession:** Our priests are available to administer this important sacrament of healing and mercy beginning 30 minutes before Mass and concluding 10 minutes before Mass begins for a total of 20 minutes. This Sacrament of Reconciliation will be offered only before daily Mass on Monday and Wednesday at 8:00 am at the OLHC Chapel, Tuesday at 8:00 am at Queen of Martyrs, Tuesday and Thursday at 11:30 am at Resurrection, and Friday at 11:30 am at St. Josaphat. Also before the Vigil Masses on Saturdays.

**Marriage:** The Sacrament for women and men in love who want to create a new Christian family. All couples who are choosing to serve the Church through the vocation of marriage are invited to schedule the ceremony with us at least 6 months before the wedding day.

**Anointing of the sick:** We administer the Sacrament of healing every Tuesday, after 12 pm Mass at Resurrection Church. Also, call us to request a home or hospital visit. Please do not postpone contacting a priest at the very moment of death but request the Sacrament when the sick person is still conscious and aware of the approaching final journey. **In case of emergency please call 716 598-0357.**

**Funerals:** Please arrange with the funeral home of your choice. They will contact our Church for you to schedule this very important Liturgical celebration for our beloved departed.

**O.C.I.A.:** The program of Christian initiation to become a member of the Catholic Church. Please contact us if called by the Holy Spirit.

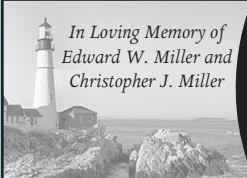
