Confessions: Our priests are available to administer this important Sacrament of Mercy. **The schedule for daily Mass confession is 20 min. before the 8:30 am Mass on Tuesday at Queen of Martyrs, the 8:30 am Mass on Wednesday at OLHC Chapel, the 12:00 pm Mass on Thursday at Resurrection, and the 12:00 pm Mass on Friday at St. Josaphat. Confession is also available before our vigil Masses.** Also, call the office for a personal appt. Every Catholic needs to go to Confession at least once a year. Holy Communion can be received during the Mass only in the state of grace (without mortal sin).

Marriage: The Sacrament for women and men in love who want to create a new Christian family. All couples who are choosing to serve the Church through the vocation of marriage are invited to schedule the ceremony with us at least 6 months before the wedding day.

Anointing of the sick: We administer the Sacrament of healing every Tuesday, after 12 pm Mass at Resurrection Church. Also, call us to request a home or hospital visit. Please do not postpone contacting a priest at the very moment of death but request the Sacrament when the sick person is still conscious and aware of the approaching final journey. **In case of emergency please call 716 598-0357.**

Welcome Fr. John Adams, Sr. Parochial Vicar

As we celebrate the Epiphany of the Lord, which recognizes Jesus as King of the Nations with the Magi coming to Jesus to pay him respect, we here at The Catholic Family of Cheektowaga are about to welcome into our faith community, Rev. John Adams. For those of you at Resurrection, he has already been a part of your community in 2013-2014, as transitional deacon in formation for priesthood.

A little background on Fr. John to get to know who he is. He is from the Pittsburgh area where he grew up with his three siblings. Moving to the WNY area, he found himself in 1997 joining St. Anthony’s Catholic Church in Farnham, becoming a eucharistic minister, member of the parish council, director of spiritual life, and a religious education instructor. In 2005, John felt the call to the priesthood.

Upon being ordained in 2014, Fr. John had several assignments including parochial vicar at SS. Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Hamburg, temporary administrator of St. Maximilian Parish in Corfu, associate professor and formation assistant director at Christ the King Seminary. Lastly, administrator/rector at the Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels in Olean, becoming Pastor in 2021.

As Fr. John returns to WNY, he will be a part of our parishes with a special assignment to implement spirituality and healing in our Diocese. Please welcome him here with me. His ministry will surely enhance our family community.

OCIA (formerly RCIA)
