Buildings and Grounds Update For Our 3 Parishes

Dear Parishioners thank you for your generous support. Because of your financial and spiritual help, faithful work of our staff and many volunteers, last year we were able to accomplish so many projects in our churches and our other parish buildings that serve our Catholic Family. We greatly appreciate the daily help of our parishioner, Mr. Mike Hora and his team of people who work so hard and with great love to make our Cemetery and Churches strong, safe and looking so beautiful. Thank you, Mr. Mike, for organizing and supervising our renovation projects, for snow removal and many others works that make it possible for us priests to focus more on pastoral service. We pray for all of you - our dear Parishioners, for your good health and many blessings from Our God. Please let us continue to preserve both our Catholic faith and the strong buildings that serve our activities. If we continue to work together in the next 5 years, I believe that everything in our 3 Parishes will be in excellent condition and we will grow in faith and in the number of people.

Our Lady Help of Christians

Church renovations for the outside and inside are complete. Landscaping will be finished in the spring. Heat and air conditioning systems are working correctly, the outside door has been renovated and painted. Parking lots have been improved and will be black sealed next year. Cemetery fences will be gradually fixed and repainted. The Mausoleum floor will be replaced soon and the roof renovated in the spring. The Chapel steeple was renovated and fixed, a new entrance to the Chapel will be constructed in the spring. Next year we will renovate the Grotto statues and stations of the cross and we will replace the altar for outside Celebrations.

The School, Rectory and Office are in excellent condition. The heating system has been fixed and works good in the school that we rent to The School of Two Hearts. All classrooms, meeting places and the Faith Formation office are in good condition. There are still some bathroom renovations that will happen soon. 15 new tables will be purchased for the upper Parish Hall.

Resurrection

We renovated and eliminated the mold problem in our Parish Hall. Everything has been renewed in this building. New tables and chairs have been purchased. Renovations of bathrooms and other small updates in all of the buildings will be done before spring. We greatly appreciate the help from our dedicated parishioners who volunteer to clean our hall, the Church and take care of the landscaping during the summer time.

The Rectory and office have been renovated and air conditioning installed. New boilers and a water heater have been installed in the Rectory and Church. The bells were installed and ring again. Landscaping renewal will continue in the spring. New handicap ramp, parking spaces and sidewalks have been renovated. All entrance doors are working. The Tabernacle was renovated and installed, all sanctuary renewed, and the pictures and statues are now in the right places in keeping with liturgical rules. New floors have been installed in the Church. Many new liturgical items have been renovated or purchased.

Thanks be to God that we were able to accomplish at Resurrection Church much more than we thought to be possible. If we will continue to receive financial support in the future, we will renovate our Church pews, outside bricks and foundations, paint the steeple, have new entrance to the Rectory, and paint the interior of the Church.

St. Josaphat

We renovated and moved our offices to the Parish building. New rooms for youth and Parish meetings were developed. The heating system, electricity and water work correctly in every building. The Rectory, old school and convent buildings heat system, electrical system and water have been disconnected. The Convent will be demolished soon.

Bathrooms in the Parish buildings will be renovated before spring. All parking lots will be restored next year. Fence was installed around the parking lot and partial renovation has been accomplished. Everything was fixed in the Church building and the water, bathrooms, lights and heat work without any problems. We will continue renovations of our bricks and outside foundation, we expect to renovate stations of the cross and repaint the interior of the Church next year. The air condition systems will be installed in the Church. There are plans for a new bathroom in the back of the church. A new outside sign will be coming in the spring. Sidewalks and outside landscaping will be renewed in the future.

We need consistent planning and work at St. Josaphat for the next 5 years, then everything will be strengthened and ready to serve for many years. We hope for continuous trust and financial support of our parishioners. In 2023, we will officially become one Family with 4 Churches working together.

Brothers and Sisters, we will not give up or stop our good holy work and service for you. This is our Church and gate to heaven.

The IHS Symbol. The familiar abbreviation IHS is a symbol of the Name Jesus which has retained its popularity down through the centuries. It owes its spread to St. Bernardine of Siena, who had it placed on his banner, surrounded with twelve rays of the sun and surmounted by a cross. It soon became the most popular monogram for the holy Name of Jesus. By his fervent words St. Bernardine persuaded many priests to place the letters on altars or on the interior and exterior walls of churches. Many Italian cities responded to his efforts and put the monogram in large letters on the outer walls of their town halls, as may still be seen in Siena.



What is its derivation? IHC is the abbreviation of the Greek ΙΗΣΟΥΣ, i.e., Jesus (the first three letters of the word). The older form for the Greek sigma, S, resembled our capital C. In Christian antiquity this monogram does not occur too frequently and may not be older than the fifth century. In recent centuries the IHS has been falsely interpreted as *Jesus Hominum Salvator*, or even *Jesu humilis societas* (and regarded as a colophon for the Society of Jesus). Another interpretation that is sometimes made is *In Hoc Signo (vinces)*, and out of the added v (for *vinces*) three nails are formed.

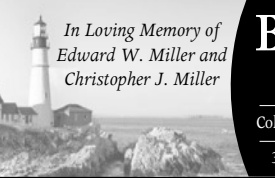
