**Confessions:** Our priests are available to administer this important Sacrament of Mercy. **The schedule for daily Mass confession is 20 min. before the 8:30 am Mass on Tuesday at Queen of Martyrs, the 8:30 am Mass on Wednesday at OLHC Chapel, the 12:00 pm Mass on Thursday at Resurrection, and the 12:00 pm Mass on Friday at St. Josaphat. Confession is also available before our vigil Masses.** Also, call the office for a personal appt. Every Catholic needs to go to Confession at least once a year. Holy Communion can be received during the Mass only in the state of grace (without mortal sin).
