At the foot of the Cross, the Lord gave us His Mother to aid humanity. Our Catholic Family of Cheektowaga has been chosen to be the first of five centers across the Diocese to offer spirituality and healing in a accessible sites so the people of God can visit or participate in spirituality and healing worship sites, devotion and liturgical experiences, retreat and respite offerings. 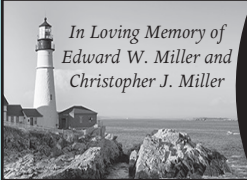


