Confession: Our priests are available to administer this important sacrament of healing and mercy beginning 30 minutes before Mass and concluding 10 minutes before Mass begins for a total of 20 minutes. This Sacrament of Reconciliation will be offered only before daily Mass on Monday and Wednesday at 8:00 am at the OLHC Chapel, Tuesday at 8:00 am at Queen of Martyrs, Tuesday and Thursday at 11:30 am at Resurrection, and Friday at 11:30 am at St. Josaphat. Also before the Vigil Masses on Saturdays.

Marriage: The Sacrament for women and men in love who want to create a new Christian family. All couples who are choosing to serve the Church through the vocation of marriage are invited to schedule the ceremony with us at least 6 months before the wedding day.

Anointing of the sick: We administer the Sacrament of healing every Tuesday, after 12 pm Mass at Resurrection Church. Also, call us to request a home or hospital visit. Please do not postpone contacting a priest at the very moment of death but request the Sacrament when the sick person is still conscious and aware of the approaching final journey. **In case of emergency please call 716 598-0357.**

Our Catholic Family of Cheektowaga's *Our Lady Queen of Peace Center of Life*

Our Lady Queen of Peace Center of Life includes participation from our parishes of Our Lady Help of Christians, Queen of Martyrs, Resurrection and St. Josaphat's sites from its parishioners and ministers to become instruments of God's spirituality and healing while imitating the Apostles and Christ's disciples as they were commissioned to do so which flowed from the Word to bring to fruition a spirituality of hope for reconciliation, rebirth, and renewal (Mark, 4:35-41; 10:52 . . . Matthew, 8:23-27; 9:6; 12:13 . . . Luke, 8:22-25; 10:9 . . . and John 11:25 . . .)

Many believe that if we are truly moving into a new era of apostolic times (a *Kairos* time), there exists an urgent call for a great shift from maintenance of our faith to mission. The primary driving force of this mission is the Holy Spirit imbuing unique gifts and charisms of evangelization, signs of power and healing, powerful conversions, forgiveness, compassion, and mercy (*paraphrasing an unknown author*).

Our Lady Queen of Peace Center of Life with other centers across the Diocese will implement Spirituality and Healing programming of Renewing of Parish Life by implementing offerings through our ministries, agency affiliates, schools, religious education groups, and organizations. We will provide a safe, sacred space of spiritual growth, healing, respite, retreat, and/or worship to those who are suffering, disenfranchised, experiencing spiritual dryness, bereavement, feeling of being harmed, injured and/or outcast.

Our Center has now established a Spiritual Life and Wellness Team composed of several representatives across our parish family. The Center is also currently recruiting individuals interested in developing a Mental Health Wellness Team. Both of these teams will address the varying needs for outreach flowing from our parish-based ministries, agencies and organizations to individuals, couples, and families. This outreach will attend to the cultural, age-related, physically disabling, and spiritually diverse needs of those seeking support. In addition, at this moment, the Center is in the process of setting up a Wellness Library that all of our parishioners and surrounding parish families will have access.

More information will be provided in terms of all future programming offered by *Our Lady Queen of Peace Center of Life*.

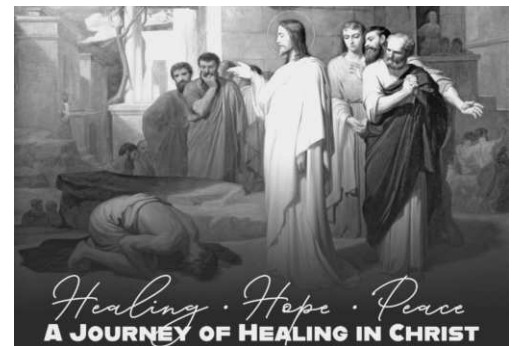

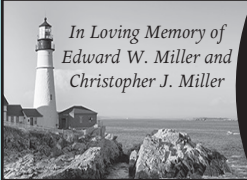
