Baptisms: Every Sunday, during or after the weekend Eucharist. Please arrange two witnesses who will become Godparents of your child. One of them must be a practicing Catholic and member of a Parish.

Faith Formation: Every child and youth need to be educated and continue to grow in faith by the help of parents, family members, and Church. Please call (716) 458-3130 to register your child for the Religious Education program or email cheektowagaff@gmail.com

Confessions: Our priests are available to administer this important Sacrament of Mercy 20 min. before every daily and vigil Masses. Also, call the office for a personal appt. Every Catholic needs to go to Confession at least once a year. Holy Communion can be received during the Mass only in the state of grace (without mortal sin).

Marriage: The Sacrament for women and men in love who want to create a new Christian family. All couples who are choosing to serve the Church through the vocation of marriage are invited to schedule the ceremony with us at least 6 months before the wedding day.

Anointing of the sick: We administer the Sacrament of healing every Tuesday, after 12 pm Mass at Resurrection Church. Also, call us to request a home or hospital visit. Please do not postpone contacting a priest at the very moment of death but request the Sacrament when the sick person is still conscious and aware of the approaching final journey.

Funerals: Please arrange with the funeral home of your choice. They will contact our Church for you to schedule this very important Liturgical celebration for our beloved departed.

R.C.I.A.: The program of Christian initiation to become a member of the Catholic Church. Please contact us if called by the Holy Spirit.

From Fr. John : Our Healing Ministry

In our world today, we may enjoy many joys and celebrations of life; however, we also experience the stresses, the challenges and the sorrows of everyday life as well. In addition, we also see or live through the tragedies of war, natural disasters, the choices of humans that oppress, destroy, and take advantage of the other from womb to the to the end of life. These sufferings and stresses affect our physical, psychological/emotional and spiritual health and well-being. As humans, we all experience the realities of life personally, but are also impacted by observing the difficulties and struggles of others. Henri Nouwen, a Dutch theologian, and writer provided many insights and knowledge about the mental health and emotional anguish accompanying the sufferings of various friends, family members, and community persons as they journeyed their paths of loss following the lived reality of his own near fatal accident.



As noted by many professionals in the helping professions, our faith helps us tremendously in dealing and coping with the traumas and stressors of everyday life. Specifically, for us Catholics, receiving the Sacraments strengthens us and provides us hope. In addition, Scripture passages such as those depicting support to one another help us to realize the value of the Lord working through and among us. Let us be consoled by the knowledge that all of us, young and old, no matter our conditions, are in God's hands and in the embrace of Divine help and are strengthened and guided by the Spirit to support one another.

In the future, our family of parishes will develop ways to help others and offer resources of support in dealing with mental health, physical and spiritual vulnerabilities.
