Faith Formation: Every child and youth need to be educated and continue to grow in faith by the help of parents, family members, and Church. Please call (716) 458-3130 to register your child for the Religious Education program or email cheektowagaff@gmail.com

Confessions: Our priests are available to administer this important Sacrament of Mercy 20 min. before every daily and vigil Masses. Also, call the office for a personal appt. Every Catholic needs to go to Confession at least once a year. Holy Communion can be received during the Mass only in the state of grace (without mortal sin).

Marriage: The Sacrament for women and men in love who want to create a new Christian family. All couples who are choosing to serve the Church through the vocation of marriage are invited to schedule the ceremony with us at least 6 months before the wedding day.

Anointing of the sick: We administer the Sacrament of healing every Tuesday, after 12 pm Mass at Resurrection Church. Also, call us to request a home or hospital visit. Please do not postpone contacting a priest at the very moment of death but request the Sacrament when the sick person is still conscious and aware of the approaching final journey. **In case of emergency please call 716 598-0357.**

Funerals: Please arrange with the funeral home of your choice. They will contact our Church for you to schedule this very important Liturgical celebration for our beloved departed.

R.C.I.A.: The program of Christian initiation to become a member of the Catholic Church. Please contact us if called by the Holy Spirit.

Student only classes will resume on Saturday, **March 15th @ 9:30** at the OLHC School Building. During the Saturday, **March 15th** student class(9:30am) Mr. Sacilowski would like to meet with all parents of students (3rd graders) who will be making their First Communion on Sunday, May 4th @ 11am. This First Communion will take place during the 11am Mass at St. Josaphat’s. This meeting is very important and is mandatory for all parents of students receiving Eucharist for the first time.

For our Saturday, **March 22nd** Family session (student(s) and parent(s)) we will be praying the St. Joseph Stations of the Cross. This will be in the OLHC church at 9:30am. Mr. Sacilowski will give a PowerPoint Lesson on the topics of Jesus’ Death and the Stations of the Cross. Following that we will then pray the Stations of the Cross together.

From Fr. John - Our Healing Ministry...



When we were born, we were chosen by the Lord and created to become a child of God. At our Baptism, we are reborn into the very life of God. During this **sacred time of Lent**, we begin our journey in the wilderness to be recreated to deepen our relationship with the Lord by coming face to face with our sins, our trials, our challenges. *We reflect on our desires, examine our motives, adjust our priorities, and evaluate our interactions.* To help, God gives us three great tools of **prayer, fasting and almsgiving**. **Prayer** is the vehicle of communication and conversation with our God to open our mind, heart, and soul to change. **Fasting** is to deprive ourselves for a short period of time of foods that we like or to limit its intake during a sacred time. Fasting can also be done by less engagement or to eliminate involvement in an activity that we take pleasure in such as being on social media, watching tv, etc. And, **Almsgiving** provides us with opportunities to give to those most in need like giving food, clothing, or monetary gifts to the poor. Almsgiving can also be sharing of ourselves with others by offering our time, talents or treasures for an individual, our family, our parish, or our community. Jesus tells us that "The Advocate, the Holy Spirit that the Father will send in my name—he will teach you everything and remind you of all that [I] told you," John 14:26.

This **Lenten Season**, during these 40 days, prepare yourself to walk in the Lord . . .

- + Try to establish a quiet and comfortable place in your home to spend alone time with Our Lord.
- + Begin, by centering yourself, free from distractions, and start the conversation by some phrase or sentence similar *Our Father (or Abba), please hear me, or Hear I am, Lord, etc.*
- + Spend several minutes telling God how much you praise and love the goodness that flows forth from the Lord and how much you have gratitude in your heart for the forgiveness, the love, the compassion and the mercy that comes from the Divine Heart. Use the *Psalms* in your Bible to help you express what is in your heart and soul or use your own words.
- + Then, listen to God's response after you ask the Lord to help you understand how best to approach this specific day in Lent and to guide you on your path to renewal and recreation.
