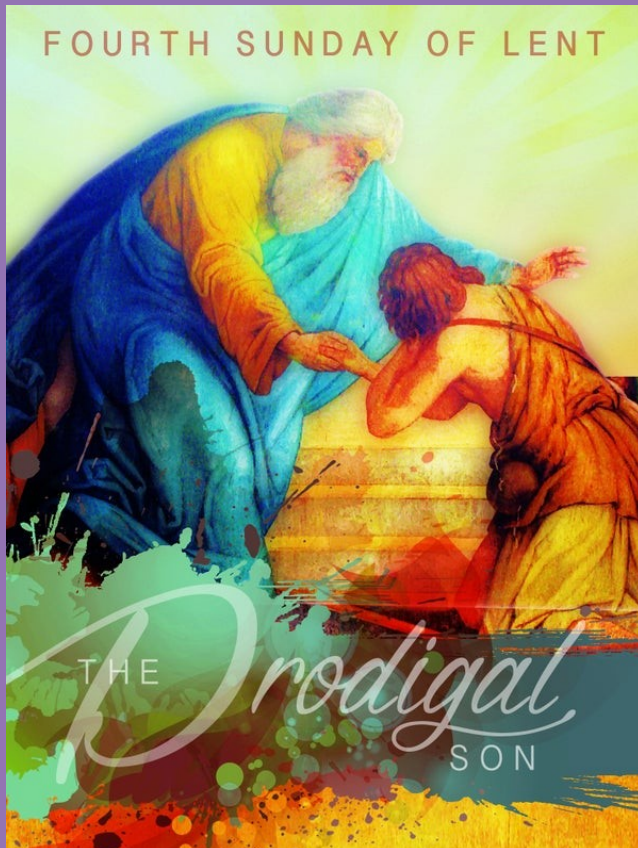

**OCIA SCRUTINIES**

On the Fifth (**March 22<sup>nd</sup>**) Sundays of Lent, Kailyn Vergara and Chase Stachoski-Fuller will celebrate the scrutinies at Our Lady Help of Christians at the 10am Mass. The scrutinies invite the Assembly to pray with them as they prepare to receive the Sacraments of Initiation.

The scrutinies strengthen their conversion, open their hearts to receive the grace of baptism and strengthen their desire to receive Christ in the Eucharist. The scrutinies are powerful rituals that contain intercessions for the Elect and a prayer of exorcism.

The scrutinies unite the Elect and the Assembly – they call us all to self-searching and repentance and remind us of the gift of salvation in Christ. ## *This Lenten Season . . . Get to Know the Lord, Our God*

Sit, kneel, stand, quietly . . . How you do so is not essential – “*For the Lord delights in you. . .*” (Isaiah, 62:4).  
 Be Still . . . Gaze upon your God who loves you. – adapted from Vinje, P. M. *Praying with Catherine of Siena*)

Always keep close in mind and in heart, our Catechism states that prayer “is a vital and personal relationship with the living and true God” (CCC, 2558). Give yourself the special gift of knowing how to talk with God – How to listen to the Lord’s voice. At times, If you do not know how to pray – just sit in silence and present yourself to your loving Lord. Ask the Lord, just to gaze upon His creation.

A beautiful way to pray when we are wanting to hear the Lord’s voice but not sure how to settle our mind or the busy world around us is to offer one adapted from scripture just like the *Jesus Prayer* when one prays for God’s mercy and love, “Jesus Christ, Son of the Living God, have mercy on me, a sinner, (Luke 18:13). A favorite scriptural passage for many can provide the way to prepare you to hear God’s voice are seen in Psalm 46:10 – *Be Still and know that I am God!* (as God is always waiting for us as a loving Father) followed by our response: 1 Samuel 3:4 – *Here I am . . .* and 1 Samuel 3: *Speak, [Lord], for Your servant is listening. . .*

An adaptation of Psalm 46:10 is also a beautiful prayer to mirror your heart’s readiness:

*Be still and know that I am God!*  
*Be still and know that I AM*  
*Be still and know*  
*Be still*  
*Be*  
*Be still*  
*Be still and know*  
*Be still and know that I AM*  
*Be Still and know that I am God!*

In this beautifully adapted prayer of unknown origin, we understand that as sands in an hourglass help us keep time on this earth, the Word of God is timeless from Heaven. Our loving God wants us to remember that He is always with us and for us and when an opportunity arises, to remain quiet and still as we search for Him and His will. As the great *I AM*, promises us that if He remains at the center of our lives, we are the center of life for Him, as the Creator loves His creation, just *Be*, be present, be open, be ready to humbly place ourselves in His Holy Presence.

Just like young Samuel, destined to be the great prophet, how do we know the Spirit through God’s voice speaking to us? The Spirit does reveal God’s Will through gifts and wonders (1 Corinthians 12:8-11), in knowing this, we should, pursue Love, and strive eagerly for His gifts, (1 Corinthians 14:1), sharing them through our Lenten Almsgiving by readying ourselves to **Listen to the Lord’s Voice.**
