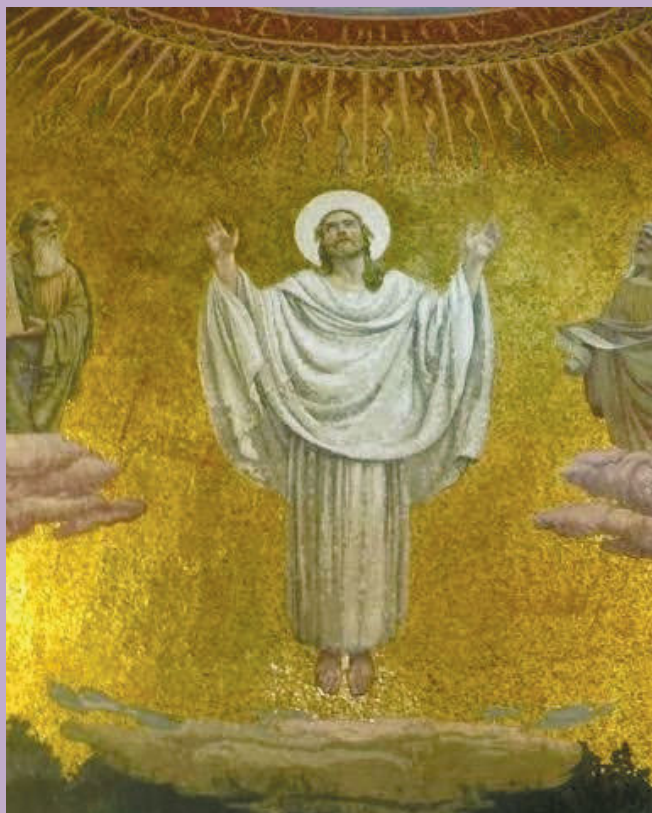

Baptisms: Every Sunday, during or after the weekend Eucharist. Please arrange two witnesses who will become Godparents of your child. One of them must be a practicing Catholic and member of a Parish.

Faith Formation: Every child and youth need to be educated and continue to grow in faith by the help of parents, family members, and Church. Please call (716) 458-3130 to register your child for the Religious Education program or email cheektowagaff@gmail.com

Confessions: Our priests are available to administer this important Sacrament of Mercy 20 min. before every daily and vigil Masses. Also, call the office for a personal appt. Every Catholic needs to go to Confession at least once a year. Holy Communion can be received during the Mass only in the state of grace (without mortal sin).

Marriage: The Sacrament for women and men in love who want to create a new Christian family. All couples who are choosing to serve the Church through the vocation of marriage are invited to schedule the ceremony with us at least 6 months before the wedding day.

Anointing of the sick: We administer the Sacrament of healing every Tuesday, after 12 pm Mass at Resurrection Church. Also, call us to request a home or hospital visit. Please do not postpone contacting a priest at the very moment of death but request the Sacrament when the sick person is still conscious and aware of the approaching final journey.

Funerals: Please arrange with the funeral home of your choice. They will contact our Church for you to schedule this very important Liturgical celebration for our beloved departed.

O.C.I.A.: The program of Christian initiation to become a member of the Catholic Church. Please contact us if called by the Holy Spirit.

For our Saturday, **March 22nd** Family session (student(s) and parent(s)) we will be praying the St. Joseph Stations of the Cross. This will be in the OLHC church at 9:30am. Mr. Sacilowski will give a PowerPoint Lesson on the topics of Jesus’ Death and the Stations of the Cross. Following that we will then pray the Stations of the Cross together.

Our Penance Retreat on Saturday, **March 29**, and begins at 10 am and goes until 1:30 pm. The retreat will be at Queen of Martyrs (George Urban Blvd). From Fr. John - Our Healing Ministry...

The primary Sacraments of Healing are seen as the Anointing of the Sick and Reconciliation (Confession or Penance). The Eucharist is the ultimate Sacrament that offers us a daily opportunity of fullness of health and life.



The Sacrament of Reconciliation: Healing Power of Confession

The Sacrament of Reconciliation also called the Sacrament of Confession or Penance, is a critical way to encounter the presence of the Lord in a deep way outside of Mass. In this beautiful Sacrament, we ask for the Lord's forgiveness and mercy for patterns of our sinfulness and for those choices we have made that have separated us from God and one another. We do so in a focused, personal and public manner. One of the important benefits of Confession is the targeted healing of the mind and the soul. Christ instituted the Healing Sacraments so we can experience the Paschal Mystery of the Passion, Death and Resurrection of the Lord in the present moment. We go to Confession to be renewed (resurrected) in our relationship with our God and one another. We choose Confession to receive the graces to strengthen us to avoid temptation to sin and to bring a halt to our patterns of behaviors and thoughts as we address our physical, mental health and spiritual struggles (Passion). We bring to surface our choices and mistakes before they grow into further separation from God and community (a spiritual erosion or death). This Lenten Season we enter into the Paschal Mystery of the Lord's passion, death and await His resurrection.

It is critical for all of us to live a life of healing. Pope Francis tells us that going to Reconciliation/Penance/Confession enriches our souls and our lives in that as we experience God's love and mercy we are likely to become more loving and merciful to others. When we confess our sins, we free ourselves of the chains of sin and those struggles with our relationships in order that we can love more freely, live more freely. Living in this love, we can now give more readily to the Lord, to others and also very importantly, to **ourselves!**

This Lent, take advantage of the opportunity to go to the healing Sacrament of Reconciliation and experience this Sacrament of Reconciliation with God and others in this beautiful gift of Healing and of Life.
