The Anointing of the Sick

Every Tuesday after the **12 pm Mass at Resurrection Parish**, Father will celebrate The Sacrament of the Healing for people who are sick with serious illnesses or conditions, those who will have surgeries and prepare for other serious medical procedures, those who have depression or other mental or psychological health conditions. 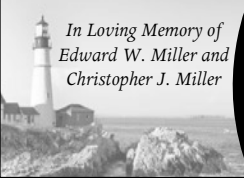
