The Month of Mary is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary

For many ages, the Catholic Church honors the Blessed Virgin Mary during the Month of May through many devotions and prayers. We celebrate the Crowing of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we pray the Rosary, we decorate Her statue and images and, in the Church, we sing hymns about the Blessed Virgin Mary. Every first Saturday, we celebrate the Fatima devotion of the First Saturdays. Everyone is invited to participate in the Mass about the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Rosary.

During the Month of May, 5 minutes before daily Masses, we will recite the Litany to the Blessed Virgin Mary, a beautiful prayer from the past, forgotten – but in need to be renewed and brought back. Some people haven't heard about this prayer, so please join us to invoke the intercession of the Blessed Virgin in our life. Holy Mary, Mother of God pray for us. Please google "Litany to the Blessed Virgin Mary" and pray privately every day in May and October.

Feast of the Ascension

The Feast of the Ascension is the fortieth day after Easter Sunday, which commemorates the Ascension of Christ into heaven, according to Mark 16:19, Luke 24:51, and Acts 1:2.

In the Eastern Church this feast was known as *analepsis*, "the taking up", and also as the *episozomene*, the salvation, denoting that by ascending into His glory, Christ completed the work of our redemption. The terms used in the West, *ascensio* and, occasionally, *ascensa*, signify that Christ was raised up by His own powers. Tradition designates Mount Olivet near Bethany as the place where Christ left the earth. The feast falls on Thursday. It is one of the Ecumenical feasts ranking with the feasts of the Passion, of Easter and of Pentecost among the most solemn in the calendar. The feast has a vigil and, since the fifteenth century, an octave which is set apart for a novena of preparation for Pentecost, in accordance with the directions of Leo XIII.

This is the Holy Day of Obligation. The Masses will be celebrated:

May 17th—4:00 pm Vigil—OLHC Church May 18th—8:30 am—Resurrection May 18th—12:00 pm—Latin Mass OLHC Chapel May 18th—7:00 pm—St. Josaphat



The Anointing of the Sick

Every Tuesday after the <u>12 pm Mass at Resurrection Parish</u>, Father will celebrate The Sacrament of the Healing for people who are sick with serious illnesses or conditions, those who will have surgeries and prepare for other serious medical procedures, those who have depression or other mental or psychological health conditions. The Anointing of the Sick cannot be given to children, youth or younger people who don't have any serious medical problem. This sacrament forgives sins and heals the soul, also strengthens the human body and mind in hope of Christ Resurrection. People are encouraged to receive Confession before the Sacrament of Anointing. Please stay in church after the Mass, move to the front of the church and receive every month the Healing that comes from Gods Mercy through Jesus Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit. **The sacrament of healing should only be received once a month.**

Holy Mass will be celebrated outside in front of the grotto on **Memorial Day**, **May, 29th at 10:00 am.** Please bring your own chairs for seating. We will enjoy the beautiful nature outside our grotto and Mary's statues of our Shrine. In case of rain, we will pray in our church building. *All 3 churches are welcome!*

This year we are planning to renovate the Grotto and all of the surrounding

statues, the Stations of the Cross leading up to the top, and install a new altar. We appreciate every donation for this project!
