### 2nd Fatima Apparition—June 13th

**Our Lady of Fatima** appeared to three shepherd children: **Lucia Dos Santos, ten years old, Jacinta and Francisco Marto, seven and nine years old respectively.**

She appeared to them six times from **May 13 to October 13, 1917**. She comes as a Mother calling men to **conversion, to prayer and penance**. She wants to spare humanity and the world from the punishments that threaten it because of the sin that has invaded it.

On **June 13<sup>th</sup>** the 3 children prayed the Rosary with the people who gathered with them. With a flash of lightning Our Lady appeared. She asked them all to pray the Rosary daily and for Lucia to learn to read. Lucia asked for the cure of a sick person. Our Lady said "If she amends her life she will be cured during the year"



Lucia asked our Lady "I want you to take us to heaven" Yes, I will take Jacinta and Francisco soon, but you must remain here some time since Jesus wishes to make use of you to make me known and loved. He wants to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart which will be your refuge and the way that will lead you to God.

As She said these last words Our Lady opened Her hands and communicated to us a second time the immense light which enveloped Her. In this light we could see ourselves submerged in God. Jacinta & Francisco seemed to be in the light which rose towards Heaven, while I was in that light which poured out over the earth. In the front of Our Lady's right hand there was a heart encircled with thorns which pierced it. We understood that it was the Immaculate Heart of Mary outraged by the sins of humanity, and that She wanted reparations.

This is what we referred to, when we said that Our Lady had told us a secret in June. Our Lady did not order us to keep it a secret on this occasion, but we felt moved to do so by God.

On the 13<sup>th</sup> day of every month from May to October, we encourage our parishioners to participate in the Holy Eucharist, receive with trust the Holy Communion and say the Rosary with connection to the Blessed Virgin asking us to pray with Her to Jesus for grace of peace and healing in our world. ***Our Lady of Fatima, pray for us!***

### St. Josaphat Kuncevych's QUATERCENTENARY 400th Martyrdom: November 12, 1623

Later this year, on Sunday, November 12, 2023 we will be celebrating the Quatercenery (400th Anniversary) of the martyrdom of St. Josaphat Kuntsevych. St Josaphat Kuntsevych is the patron saint of Saint Josaphat's Parish in our family of three parishes, Resurrection and Our Lady Help of Christians, and soon to be fourth parish with the addition of Queen of Martyrs. I see no better time than now to begin to prepare for these events by invoking the assistance of Saint Josaphat who was a great preacher of unity. And it was for this very unity of the Church that he paid the ultimate price with his own blood defending the unity of the Church from those who sought to continue division; those of the Eastern Orthodox faith who did not see the Pope in Rome as their head of their Church. God wants unity.

In John's gospel, Chapter 17, verses 11, and 20-23, Jesus speaks to his Father saying, "And now I will no longer be in the world, but they are in the world, while I am coming to you. Holy Father, keep them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one just as we are." "I pray not only for them, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, so that they may all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I in you, that they may believe that you sent me. And I have given them the glory you gave me, so that they may be one, as we are one, I in them and you in me, that they may be brought to perfection as one, that they may know that you sent me, and that you loved them even as you loved me."

Saint Paul talks about unity in the Church (Christ's Body) in his letter to the Ephesians, Chapter 4, verses 1-6 "I, then, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to live in a manner worthy of the call you have received, with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another through love, striving to preserve the unity of the spirit through the bond of peace.: one body and one Spirit, as you were also called to the one hope of your call: one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all."

On many Sundays at mass when we say the Nicene Creed we say: "I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins."

As we move closer to this celebration, each month, we will learn more about the life of St. Josaphat Kuntsevych. What made him fight for unity so fervently? How did he accomplish this task, even with his death?

I would like you to begin to ask yourself "How God is calling me to help unify His Church right now in this diocese, in this parish? What gifts, skills, or talents do I have to help our parish family as we continue to unify in Christ? We are not doing any of this alone, but we are being aided by the Holy Spirit, the Advocate, by the intercession of Saint Josaphat. Be bold and do not be afraid. **Everyone from all 3 Churches are invited to celebrate Mass in November!**

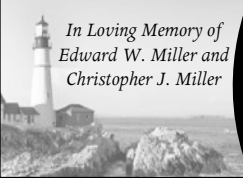
