

To revive parish life, we embraced input from multiple sources including the Movement to Restore Trust, as well as Vicariate listening sessions. Additional feedback on our diocese was gathered through the 2022 Synod sessions: Listening in Love and Hope, Conversation About the Church. The Road to Renewal program that began in 2020 continues to pursue its visionary effort to reorganize our churches into 36 Families of Parishes.

Future plans for OLHC Grotto

Dear parishioners of OLHC. This year we are planning to restore our Beautiful Grotto Altar, Stations of the Cross, and all Statues of Mary and the Saints around it. Some statues in the Grotto are deteriorated, other places are waiting for new Saints.

We are looking to purchase 4 new outside statues that will last for many, many years. Each will be 5 to 6 feet tall, and most likely be purchased from artists in Italy. If anyone would like to sponsor one statue, it will be greatly appreciated. Next to the statue we will install little plates with memorial dedication from the donor. Each statue and its installation will cost approximately \$10,000.00. We will have a better idea of cost once the order is finalized. We have already received sponsors for the purchase of the St Joseph and St Padre Pio statues. We are still looking for sponsors for St Michael Archangel and the Blessed Virgin Mary statue to replace the current statue in the memorial walk. The Anointing of the Sick

Every Tuesday after the 12 pm Mass at Resurrection Parish, Father will celebrate The Sacrament of the Healing for people who are sick with serious illnesses or conditions, those who will have surgeries and prepare for other serious medical procedures, those who have depression or other mental or psychological health conditions. The Anointing of the Sick cannot be given to children, youth or younger people who don't have any serious medical problem. This sacrament forgives sins and heals the soul, also strengthens the human body and mind in hope of Christ Resurrection. People are encouraged to receive Confession before the Sacrament of Anointing. Please stay in church after the Mass, move to the front of the church and receive every month the Healing that comes from Gods Mercy through Jesus Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit.

The sacrament of healing should only be received once a month.
