

On **July 18-19** at the same time when thousands of our brothers and sisters will pray in Indianapolis, we will pray with them, participating in 24 Hours of Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in our OLHC Chapel (Thursday from 8:30am till Friday 8:30am). We will begin on **July 18 at 8:00am with** the Family Rosary Across America & then at **8:30am** with the Celebration of the Most Holy Eucharist & finish on **July 19 at 8:30am with** the Eucharistic Celebration with 24-hour nonstop Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. 
