### 3rd Apparition of Our Lady of Fatima —July 13, 1917



“I want you to come here on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of next month. Continue to say the Rosary every day, in honor of Our Lady in order to obtain peace for the world and the end of the war, because only She can obtain it “

“Continue to come here every month. In October I will tell you who I am and what I want and I will perform a miracle so that all may believe.”

“Sacrifice yourselves for sinners and say often, especially when you make some sacrifice: Oh Jesus, this is for love of You, for the conversion of sinners, and in reparation for the sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary.”

Saying these last words, Our Lady opened her hands, as She had done during the 2 previous months.

The light from them seemed to penetrate the earth, and we saw a sea of fire. Plunged in this fire were demons and souls that looked like transparent embers, some black or bronze, in human form, driven about by the flames that issued from within themselves together with clouds of smoke. They were falling on all sides, just as sparks cascade from great fires, without weight or equilibrium, amid cries of pain and despair which horrified us so that we trembled with fear. (It must have been this sight which caused me to cry out, as the people say they heard me exclaim aloud.) The demons could be distinguished by their likeness to terrible, loathsome, and unknown animals, transparent as live coals. Terrified and as if to plead for succor, we raised our eyes to Our Lady, who said to us kindly but sadly:

You have seen hell where the souls of poor sinners go. In order to save them, God wishes to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart. If you do what I tell you, many souls will be saved and there will be peace. The war will end, but if men do not cease offending God, another and more terrible war will break out during the pontificate of Pius XI. When you see a night lit up by an unknown light, know that is the sign God gives you that He is about to punish the world for its crimes by means of war, hunger, persecution of the Church and the Holy Father. In order to prevent this, I shall come to ask for the consecration of Russia to my Immaculate Heart, and the Communion or reparation on the 1<sup>st</sup> Saturdays. If my wishes are fulfilled, Russia will be converted and there will be peace. If not, Russia will spread her errors throughout the world, promoting wars, and persecution of the Church. The good will be martyred, the Holy Father will have much to suffer, and various nations will be annihilated. But in the end, my Immaculate Heart will triumph. The Holy Father will consecrate Russia to me and it will be converted, and a time of peace will be conceded to the world.

### St. Josaphat Kuncevych's Quatercentenary 400<sup>th</sup> Martyrdom: November 12, 1623 The Birth and Youth of St. Josaphat

In the rich and fertile country of Ukraine, devastated by foreign invaders and occupied by schismatics. In 1580, in the town of Volodymyr, Josaphat was born to a humble and pious family. He was baptized with the name John (which means “the grace of God”) in the Church of St. Parasceve\*.

His father, Gabriel Kunceвич, although a gentleman of the middle class, due to poverty, had to work as a tradesman as a grain merchant. His mother, Marianna, was from a modest noble family and although she could scarcely write or read, she had a remarkable memory. Like all Ukrainian children, instead of Mother Goose, she taught Josaphat parables from the bible, about the Holy Family, and the life of Jesus. Marianna would sing him “O Mary, Mother of God, pray for us” as a lullaby.

John had an uncommon interest in religion, and was a serious boy with a terrific presence of mind, reflective, but few of words, thinking more than he spoke and full of admiration of the piety of his mother. “Virtue passes easily from the hearts of mothers into the hearts of children.”

Josaphat relays an incident from his childhood to his friend, Hennedy Khmelnytsky: while at church, Josaphat was attracted to an icon of Our Lord Jesus on the Cross and asked his mother about it. She tried to explain in language Josaphat, as a child, would understand about the Saviour of mankind, who for the love of humanity from heaven, descended to earth and permitted himself to be nailed to the cross to save mankind from hell.

The child gazed in awe and within him, an ardent stirring filled him with a great love for the Crucified Lord. Josaphat told his friend, “At that moment, I saw a spark of fire leave the side of our Lord and enter my heart. I was suddenly overwhelmed by such an abundance of sweetness and love that I stood very still, seeing and hearing nothing, and from that moment on, such a great love was born in me for the Saviour of mankind and my Rite that for thirty years I never once neglected the Church rule and could only think of imitating Him in His life and poverty and suffering.”

As a result of this event, his behavior changed. As he grew, he was utmostly concerned with how to please God by being diligent in all his undertakings out of obedience, love for others, being cheerful in the acceptance of his duties, disappointments, hardships, and misfortunes.

The uncommon earnestness and angelic piety of the young boy caught the attention of the entire town. They all admired him and pointed him out as an example to their children to imitate and to become better Christians.

When the young John was corrected by his mother, it was with the utmost gentleness so that all she needed to say to him was “God sees all that you do.” He grew in God’s grace and wisdom. He learned early in life that by charity and gentleness he could make the best kind of friends.

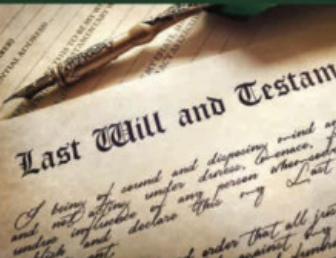
