


Building and Grounds Updates for Our 3 Parishes

OLHC

New air conditioning system has been installed in front of the Chapel. It is working very quietly. When the one in the back of the Chapel expires, we will replace it with a modern one as well.

New entrance to the Chapel project has been prepared and will be completed this year.

Landscaping around church will be completed in July.

Grotto renovation in progress. We will power clean and restore all our statues, install 4 new ones before winter, restore stations of the cross. New Grotto Altar will be completed in the winter.

Mausoleum floor is installed as well as candle holders. The Mausoleum roof will be fixed before winter.

We have plans to fix cemetery fence and install new electrical sign. We will fix some of the damages from the winter storm around our property when we receive the money from insurance.

Black sealing and new strips of our parking lot after all heavy works is completed.

Many small improvements in all our buildings have been done due to the generosity and hard work of Mr. Mike Hora and his team of people. We thank them greatly and all our volunteers who help.

Resurrection

New boilers installed, landscaping renovated, old sign and flag pall removed. Fr. Marcin's Rectory and office renovation completed. Parish hall roof leaks from winter storm has been fixed. We will observe our roof on parish hall to make sure that all building is in excellent shape.

We have plans to renovate the restrooms in the Church and hall, paint the doors in the hall, and some other small work that was not done properly during demolition project. We will fix the parking lot cracks to keep it in excellent shape.

Next year plan is to restore all outside bricks, cracks in foundations and exterior damage around the windows. We will repaint the steeple on the Church.

Also, many small improvements in the basement of Church and in all our buildings was done during winter and spring time by Mr. Mike and all our volunteers. Thank you to all. Thank you to Mr. Phil for mowing our grounds and Mr. Patrick for keeping our Church and grounds so clean and beautiful every day. I am so amazed with the number of people who help us in every church. Thank you!

St. Josaphat

We have been continuing the brick and outside Church wall restorations. We hope to finish it this year.

Our stations of the cross have been restored and repainted. They look beautiful and holy with Holy Land crosses installed above every station.

We have plans to install a restroom at the entrance of the church and improve the restrooms in the parish center.

Some landscaping improvement have happened. Thank you to our volunteers for the beautiful flowers and landscaping work.

We are waiting for a new Church sign to be installed.

Meanwhile, hundreds of little projects and improvements were done in the Parish Center and Church buildings by Mr. Mike and his people. Thank you for this work and your service to our Church.

There is a planned demolition of our convent before winter and restoration of new sidewalks and parking lot around the Church next year.
