

"CEMETERY OF THE INNOCENTS" MEMORIAL

The Respect Life Ministry begins anew each year on Respect Life Sunday, the first Sunday of October. In honor of this, Queen of Martyrs, Our Lady Help of Christians, Resurrection, and St Josaphat Parishes are hosting the Cemetery of the Innocents at Queen of Martyrs on Thursday, September 28th @ 5:30pm. 
