INFORMATION FOR ALL PARISHIONERS

Baptisms: Every Sunday, during or after the Eucharist. Please arrange two witnesses who will become the Godparents of your child. One of them must be a practicing Catholic and member of a Parish Church.

Faith Formation: Every child and youth need to be educated and continue to grow in faith by the help of parents, family members, and Church. Please call (716) 458-3130 to register your child for the Religious Education program.

Confessions: Our priests are available to administer this important Sacrament of Mercy 20 min. before every daily and vigil Masses. Also, call the office for a personal appointment. Every Catholic needs to go to Confession at least once a year. Holy Communion can be received during the Mass only in the state of grace (without mortal sin).

Marriage: The Sacrament for women and men in love that want to create a new Christian family together and with God. All couples who are choosing to serve the Church through the vocation of marriage are invited to schedule the ceremony at least 6 months before the wedding day. At least one of them needs to be Catholic and registered at one of our Parishes.

Anointing of the sick: We administer the Sacrament every Tuesday, after 12 pm Mass at Resurrection Church. Also, call us to request a home or hospital visit. Please do not postpone contacting a priest at the very moment of death but request the Sacrament when the sick person is still conscious and aware of the approaching final journey.

Funerals: Please arrange with the funeral home of your choice. They will contact our Church for you to schedule this very important Liturgical celebration for our beloved departed.

R.C.I.A.: The program of Christian initiation to become a member of the Catholic Church. Please contact us if called by the Holy Spirit.

New Parishioners: Always welcome to register and support us through time, talent, and treasure. Registration Forms are available in the back of our Churches. Please visit or contact our office to register or notify us when moving out of the Parish.

Letter of Recommendation: These are testimonies to the fact that you are a practicing Catholic in the Parish. Please use contribution envelopes to indicate attendance. To be a sponsor, a person needs to be confirmed, registered at our Parish, and attending Holy Mass at our Church. Please call the office of your membership to receive a letter of good stands to become a Godparent for Baptism or Sponsor for Confirmation.

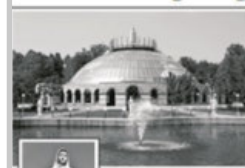

On Saturday **November 4th @ 6pm**, at Queen of Martyrs, we welcome the Venerable Nelson Baker to the stage. You will hear the life story of Father Baker through a live theatrical one-man presentation entitled "She Did It All!" From a typical family in Buffalo, you will see how he placed his life in the hands of Our Lady of Victory while dedicating his life to the marginalized, poor, and orphaned. See how Father Baker recovers from a deadly infection that put him on the brink of death only to lead him to discover this lasting devotion to the Blessed Mother. Witness how his trust in Mary's intercession transformed a bankrupt orphanage and protectory into one of the greatest institutions of its kind in America. Listen to how he then built a basilica to give thanks and honor to the Mother of God for her constant patronage. This is a **FREE** event for all!!

6th APPARITION AT FATIMA October 13, 1917

The 3 children left home early due to the large crowds along the way. The air was very chilly and the rain was torrential, however, people just kept walking to the apparition sight. Not even the very muddy earth prevented the people from kneeling. When Lucia arrived, she asked all the people to close their umbrellas and pray the Rosary together. Our Lady arrives on the small Holm-oak tree as usual. What do you want of me Lucia asks. Our Lady replies, "I want to tell you to have a little Chapel built here in my honor as I am the Lady of the Rosary. I also want you to continue to pray the Rosary every day." Lucia asks for the cure of many sick people and for the conversion of sinners. Our Lady speaks, "Some yes; others no. They need to make amends, to ask forgiveness for their sins" and taking on a deep sadness, Our Lady says "Do not offend Our Lord anymore for He is already so much offended."

As our Lady began her departure, Lucia shouted to the crowd which now was at least 70,000 people. LOOK AT THE SUN! The rain stopped, the clouds parted and everyone could look directly at the sun without any harm to their eyes. The sun came out of its orbit, zigzagging and spinning, throwing off different colors which settled on the people's skin, clothes, trees, rocks, and stones. The sun began to rotate and seemed to be hurtling towards the earth. Most people were terrified, some were confessing their sins, many were praying with trembling voices. While this was happening, the children saw beside the sun, St. Joseph with the Child Jesus and Our Lady robed in white with a blue mantle. St Joseph and the Child Jesus seemed to bless the world for they made the Sign of the Cross over the people. When this vision ended, they now saw Our Lord and Our Lady of Sorrows. Our Lord seemed to bless the world in the same manner as St. Joseph did. This vision disappeared, and we saw Our Lady again, this time as Our Lady of Mt. Carmel.

When the people feared that they would be crushed by the falling sun, it immediately returned to its place in the sky. Another wonderful gift and miracle obtained by Our Lady who is Our Holy Mother was that all the people's wet clothes full of drenching mud were totally dry and completely clean. This was the final apparition for the 3 children in Fatima.
