

INFORMATION FOR ALL PARISHIONERS

Baptisms: Every Sunday, during or after the weekend Eucharist. Please arrange two witnesses who will become the Godparents of your child. One of them must be a practicing Catholic and member of a Parish Church.

Faith Formation: Every child and youth need to be educated and continue to grow in faith by the help of parents, family members, and Church. Please call (716) 458-3130 to register your child for the Religious Education program.

Confessions: Our priests are available to administer this important Sacrament of Mercy 20 min. before every daily and vigil Masses. Also, call the office for a personal appointment. Every Catholic needs to go to Confession at least once a year. Holy Communion can be received during the Mass only in the state of grace (without mortal sin).

Marriage: The Sacrament for women and men in love who want to create a new Christian family. All couples who are choosing to serve the Church through the vocation of marriage are invited to schedule the ceremony with us at least 6 months before the wedding day.

Anointing of the sick: We administer the Sacrament of healing every Tuesday, after 12 pm Mass at Resurrection Church. Also, call us to request a home or hospital visit. Please do not postpone contacting a priest at the very moment of death but request the Sacrament when the sick person is still conscious and aware of the approaching final journey.

Funerals: Please arrange with the funeral home of your choice. They will contact our Church for you to schedule this very important Liturgical celebration for our beloved departed.

R.C.I.A.: The program of Christian initiation to become a member of the Catholic Church. Please contact us if called by the Holy Spirit.

New Parishioners: Always welcome to register and support us through time, talent, and treasure. Registration Forms are available in the back of our Churches. Please visit or contact our office to register or notify us when moving out of the Parish.

Letter of Recommendation: This is a testimony to the fact that you are a practicing Catholic. Please use contribution envelopes to indicate attendance. To be a sponsor, a person needs to be confirmed, registered at our Parish, and attending Holy Mass. Please call the office of your membership to receive a letter of good stands to become a Godparent for Baptism or Sponsor for Confirmation.

Buildings and Grounds Update

Dear Parishioners of Our Catholic Family of Cheektowaga,

With thanksgiving to God and great appreciation to all of you who support, volunteer and serve in our beautiful Churches, I would like to share with you our accomplishments and future plans for our Parish facilities. Each of us understands that in the Church most important is faith in God, Christian charity and hope, prayer and mutual support. At the same time, we also need our strong and safe buildings to worship and pray and to walk together to heavenly glory. We thank everyone with all our hearts who helps, especially Mr. Mike Hora our facility manager and his people for dedication and service and support of many projects we have done during 2023 in our buildings and grounds and for our OLHC cemetery.

In **Queen of Martyrs** Parish since July, we have cleaned the Church building and its basement, improved our heating systems in every Parish building, kept clean the outside landscaping, and prepared renovation plans for Church confessionals, candles area, and will make the offices accessible to everyone. We want to prepare beautiful a meeting room for Bible study and other important functions. We cleaned our Parish sacristy, provided new altar cloths, cleaned all vestments, renewed candle glasses that are going to hold 5 days votive candles. Our future plans is to continue school rent with Buffalo Hearing Center, continue school building improvements (especially new windows, carpets, bathrooms and doors). In the spring, we will remove some old trees from landscaping, trim some bushes and continue to strengthen and beatify every small area of our facilities. Our priorities are the remodeling of the Confessionals in the Church and office rooms.

St. Josaphat accomplished so much during this passing 2023 year. Office buildings, restoration of the stations of the cross, majority of Church bricks restored, the heating systems improved, convent removed, roofs fixed, new Church sign to be installed, improvements with parking lots, landscaping, Church floor and many others. The greatest event was our beautiful celebration of 400 years of St. Josaphat Martyrdom. We have plans to continue next year with new windows in the Parish center basement, finish all brick restoration of the Church tower, restore Church doors, prepare project for new parking lot in the area of convent building, improvements with landscaping, and new bathroom at the main entrance of the Church. We also want to paint inside of the Church if our financial condition will allow us.

Resurrection Church building and entrance, Fr. Marcin house, office and Parish hall are in very good condition from what we have accomplished in the past few years. We installed new boilers in all our buildings. Parish center bathrooms will be restored during the winter, we will restore Church pews and if financially feasible, we will beatify the inside paintings and restore them. We also want to paint our Church steeple and restore some broken bricks and outside frames of the windows. Improvements of landscaping will continue and all will be kept beautiful and holy.

Our Lady Help of Christians, Church, Chapel, Cemetery, Parish and faith formation center, central office and Fr. Jozef house, parking lots in great condition. We enjoy our buildings excellent condition and are thankful to Mr. Mike Hora for the last three years of his hard work and dedication. Our cemetery grotto will receive new statues of saints, outside stations of the cross will be restored in the summer, our office will receive new entrance very soon as well our Chapel of our Lady. Never ending school building improvements will continue, as well whatever is possible to improve in our Chapel, Church, Cemetery. We will not leave behind anything what we can improve and better serve our people to pray and worship. We will do the same in every Church of our Family. Every Parish will be treated with the same care, respect and dedication because our buildings help you, our beloved people, to pray, receive grace and go to heaven in the future.

Thank you, our dear Parishioners, for your trust, help, financial support, good words and all prayers. We are here for you, enjoying your friendship and same holy journey. Our Churches are needed more than anything in our lives, for our communities, for the future of our children and grandchildren. Please continue to care for your beautiful hearts and every Sunday fill your souls with Devine nourishment.
