INFORMATION FOR ALL PARISHIONERS

Baptisms: Every Sunday, during or after the weekend Eucharist. Please arrange two witnesses who will become the Godparents of your child. One of them must be a practicing Catholic and member of a Parish Church.

Faith Formation: Every child and youth need to be educated and continue to grow in faith by the help of parents, family members, and Church. Please call (716) 458-3130 to register your child for the Religious Education program.

Confessions: Our priests are available to administer this important Sacrament of Mercy 20 min. before every daily and vigil Masses. Also, call the office for a personal appointment. Every Catholic needs to go to Confession at least once a year. Holy Communion can be received during the Mass only in the state of grace (without mortal sin).

Marriage: The Sacrament for women and men in love who want to create a new Christian family. All couples who are choosing to serve the Church through the vocation of marriage are invited to schedule the ceremony with us at least 6 months before the wedding day.

Anointing of the sick: We administer the Sacrament of healing every Tuesday, after 12 pm Mass at Resurrection Church. Also, call us to request a home or hospital visit. Please do not postpone contacting a priest at the very moment of death but request the Sacrament when the sick person is still conscious and aware of the approaching final journey.

Funerals: Please arrange with the funeral home of your choice. They will contact our Church for you to schedule this very important Liturgical celebration for our beloved departed.

R.C.I.A.: The program of Christian initiation to become a member of the Catholic Church. Please contact us if called by the Holy Spirit.

New Parishioners: Always welcome to register and support us through time, talent, and treasure. Registration Forms are available in the back of our Churches. Please visit or contact our office to register or notify us when moving out of the Parish.

Letter of Recommendation: This is a testimony to the fact that you are a practicing Catholic. Please use contribution envelopes to indicate attendance. To be a sponsor, a person needs to be confirmed, registered at our Parish, and attending Holy Mass. Please call the office of your membership to receive a letter of good stands to become a Godparent for Baptism or Sponsor for Confirmation.

Important information For Our Family of 4 Parishes

1. Each of the particular Parish Pastoral and Financial Councils will no longer officially meet in December and January. We are preparing to form one Family Parish and Finance Council that will meet for the first time in February. We will rotate our meetings with our 4 Churches each month. Both Pastoral and Finance Councils will be built out of representatives from each Parish community and our Priests. Existing Parish or Financial Councils are welcome to continue to meet regularly but without our Priests to discuss the needs of their Parish and bring it to our Family meetings through their representatives.

2. The new schedule has been announced and officially begins on January 2, 2024. The schedule was established by the liturgical pillar consisting of parishioners from each of our 4 communities. We remind you again that no matter what building you attend the Eucharist, your donation will be returned to the parish of your membership. We humbly ask our parishioners not to leave us because of a schedule change but to try to adjust your personal life schedule with our Mass times. Everyone who leaves will make us weaker in our church, but most of all, it hurts his own spiritual well-being.

3. Everyone is asked to be kind and nice to our Priests and do not express negativity towards those who are not responsible for all the changes or problems that we are experiencing now in our local churches. Our Priests always want to help and lead us out of crisis. We will achieve more spiritual fruits and lead more people to heaven only by loving and respecting each other. Thank you for your understanding that we all struggle and feel pain because of the new challenges and changes but we also hope that God will help us to sustain faith In Christ in our Churches.

Everyone is important and asked to pray and work together.


4. The financial statements from each parish for the fiscal year of 2022/2023 will be announced in our Bulletin during the month of January.

5. The Faith Formation program will merge into one Family Discipleship Faith Formation program as requested by the Diocese beginning June 1, 2024, after all Sacraments are received and present school year ends. Beginning September 2024, we will teach our children, youth and adults who want to deepen their knowledge of faith in one location decided by our administration pillar and approved by our Diocese. The details will be given to all parents, catechists and parishioners after Easter.
