### EASTER SEASON

The word "Easter" comes from Old English, meaning simply the "East." The sun which rises in the East, bringing light, warmth, and hope, is a symbol for the Christian of the rising Christ, who is the true Light of the world. The Paschal Candle used during the Easter Vigil is a central symbol of this divine light, which is Christ. It is kept near the ambo throughout Easter Time and lit for all liturgical celebrations.

The Easter Vigil is the "Mother of All Vigils" and Easter Sunday is the greatest of all Sundays. The season of Easter is the most important of all liturgical times, which Catholics celebrate as the Lord's resurrection from the dead, culminating in his Ascension to the Father and sending of the Holy Spirit upon the Church. The octave of Easter comprises the eight days which stretch from the first to the second Sunday. It is a way of prolonging the joy of the initial day. There are 50 days of Easter from the first Sunday to Pentecost. It is characterized, above all, by the joy of glorified life and the victory over death expressed most fully in the great resounding cry of the Christian: Alleluia! All faith flows from faith in the resurrection: "If Christ has not been raised, then empty is our preaching; empty, too, is your faith." (1 Cor 15:14)

The Paschal Mystery culminates in the Ascension of Jesus that is celebrated 40 days after Easter Sunday. After his appearance here on earth in his risen body, and "after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen" (Acts 1:2), Jesus "was lifted up and a cloud took him from their sight" (Acts 1:9):

*The Solemnity of Pentecost, on the fiftieth day of Easter, concludes the Easter season.*

Pentecost marks the occasion of God sending the Holy Spirit upon Jesus' disciples after his Resurrection. The book of Acts describes how the disciples were gathered together in one place on the day of Pentecost. The Jewish feast of Pentecost (Shavuot or the Feast of Weeks) was a day that commemorated the giving of the law to Moses, a day soon to be marked as well by the giving of the Holy Spirit. The day of Pentecost was a turning point for the disciples of Christ.

*At the conclusion of the Mass during the Day, the Paschal Candle is extinguished and moved to its permanent location near the baptismal font.*

### The Month of May is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary

For many ages, the Catholic Church honors the Blessed Virgin Mary during the Month of May through many devotions and prayers. We celebrate the Crowning of the Blessed Virgin Mary, we pray the Rosary, we decorate Her statue and images and in the Church we sing hymns about the Blessed Virgin Mary. Every first Saturday especially on **May 7<sup>th</sup>** at Resurrection at 8:30 am, we celebrate the Fatima devotion of the First Saturdays. Everyone is invited to participate in the Mass about the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Rosary.

**During the Month of May**, 5 minutes before daily Masses, we will recite The Litany to the Blessed Virgin Mary, beautiful prayer from the past, forgotten - but in need to be renewed and brought back. Some people haven't heard about this prayer, so please join us to invoke the intercession of Blessed Virgin in our life. Holy Mary, Mother of God pray for us. Please google "Litany to the Blessed Virgin Mary" and pray privately in May and October every day.

### The Anointing of the Sick

**Every Tuesday after the 12 pm Mass at Resurrection Parish**, Father will celebrate The Sacrament of the Healing for people who are sick with serious illnesses or conditions, those who will have surgeries and prepare for other serious medical procedures, those who have depression or other mental or psychological health conditions. The Anointing of the Sick cannot be given to children, youth or younger people who don't have any serious medical problem. This sacrament forgives sins and heals the soul, also strengthens the human body and mind in hope of Christ Resurrection. People are encouraged to receive Confession before the Sacrament of Anointing. Please stay in church after the Mass, move to the front of the church and receive every month the Healing that comes from Gods Mercy through Jesus Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit. **The sacrament of healing should only be received once a month.**

### World Youth Days 2023 – Lisbon, Portugal

Fr. Jozef invites all youth ages 16 – 50 to participate in World Youth Days Pilgrimage. In the past, Fr. Jozef organized similar pilgrimages with the youth to Australia, Spain, Poland, and Germany. 
