### CORPUS CHRISTI AT ST. JOSAPHAT'S CHURCH

In order to honor our Lord's gift of himself to mankind in the Most Blessed Sacrament in a public and shameless manner, St. Josaphat's Church is proud to announce its annual Corpus Christi procession.

Everyone from all three churches is invited on Sunday, June 19, 2022 to attend and show their devotion and thanksgiving to our Lord, for giving us so profound a mystery. Immediately following the 11:00 a.m. Mass, a Eucharistic procession will take place from main altar of St. Josaphat's Church to the outside area around the church, and will end at the grotto of Our Lady of Lourdes, with prayers and a final blessing.

Afterwards, everyone is invited to attend an ice cream social in the newly renovated parish hall. *In the event of inclement weather, the procession will take place inside the church.*

### St. Josaphat's Building Restoration Campaign

After years of weathering, and wear and tear, St. Josaphat's Church is now in great need of a major capital project to restore all of its exterior brick. These significant structural repairs are vital towards our parish continuing its mission in serving the needs of our parishioners and remaining preserved for future generations. Furthermore, delay in completing this project will only additionally compromise the structure of the church building, already experiencing difficulties from water damage due to the weathering and erosion of the church masonry. If we as a parish do not act on these issues now, there will be no church building left to worship in.

After numerous inquiries and estimates and *with the approval of the Diocese of Buffalo*, the company chosen to spearhead the project of restoring the masonry here at St. Josaphat's Church was Raymond E. Kelly Inc. The approximate cost to complete the project is \$190,000. Currently, the parish has approximately \$180,000 within its savings to cover a small portion of this project, but not all. We would like to use the money in our savings account to help us with other projects currently ongoing at the parish. In light of this, we are faced with the difficulty and unpleasantness of having to ask our parishioners to consider assisting us in this extensive endeavor. We only ask that everyone contribute what they are able to. For those unable to finance the project at all, we humbly ask for your prayers as we take on this task.

In the coming weeks, each parishioner will receive in the mail a detailed letter explaining the nature of the project, and asking them if they would personally consider contributing to this important project. If you so choose to donate to the cause, we ask that you indicate on the memo line of your checks the following: *'Church Capital Campaign'*. We ask for your patience and understanding as we embark on these projects together to help preserve our parish for future generations, and work to restore it to its original beauty. The mission of this parish is to get everyone to heaven and we need a sound church building to help us achieve that goal. Any assistance from you the parishioner is greatly appreciated and will be rewarded by our Lord himself.


