"YOUTH FOR CHRIST" serves to create an atmosphere for our young people to socialize while engaging deeper into their Catholic Faith through solid catechesis, instruction in the life of prayer, and active participation in the life of the parish and the liturgy. 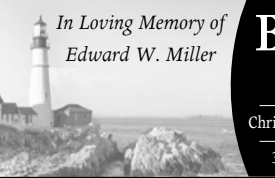

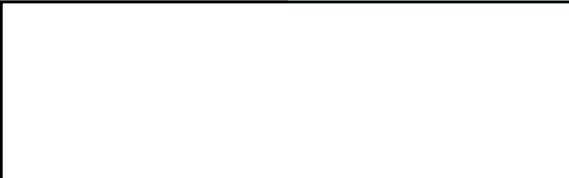
