- Phase 1 FoPs are estimated to be inaugurated May 1, 2023.

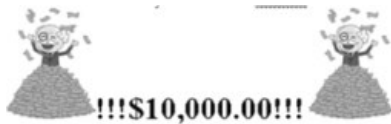

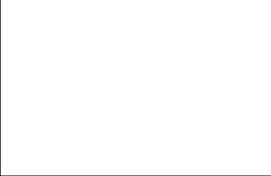

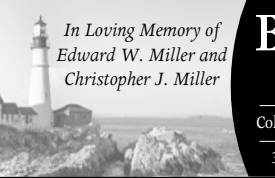
