### Catechism Song: "12 Days of Christmas"

Legend has it that this song was written during a time of persecution in England between 1558-1829 as a catechism song for young Catholics who were forbidden to practice their faith. Each number signifies a teaching of our Faith. The song can be understood on two different levels—the literal meaning of the words, which appear harmless enough to a stranger, and the hidden meaning behind those words which expressed the religious beliefs of a people who could have been killed an account of their Catholic faith.

**1<sup>st</sup> Day** - "True Love" represents God and "me" the baptized soul. The "partridge in a pear tree" is Jesus, symbolically shown as a mother partridge pretending injury to lure predators away from her nestlings. The mother dies to protect her young.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Day** - "Two Turtle Doves" are the Old and New Testament of the Bible.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Day** - "Three French Hens" were beautiful and costly birds in those days. They represent faith, hope and charity, which can be given by God alone.

**4<sup>th</sup> Day** - "Four Calling Birds" are the *four* Gospels written by Matthew, Mark, Luke and John.

**5<sup>th</sup> Day** - "Five Golden Rings" are the first *five* books of the Bible known as the Law, Torah or Pentateuch.

**6<sup>th</sup> Day** - "Six Geese a Laying" are the *six* days when God created everything.

**7<sup>th</sup> Day** - "Seven Swans A Swimming" represent the *seven* gifts of the Holy Spirit: Wisdom, Understanding, Counsel, Fortitude, Knowledge, Piety and Fear of the Lord.

**8<sup>th</sup> Day** - "Eight Maids of Milking" represent the *eight* Beatitudes in Matthew's Gospel.

**9<sup>th</sup> Day** - "Nine Ladies Dancing" refers to the *nine* fruits of the Holy Spirit: Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Generosity, Faithfulness, Gentleness and Self-Control.

**10<sup>th</sup> Day** - "Ten Lords A Leaping" represent the *ten* commandments which guide our lives.

**11<sup>th</sup> Day** - "Eleven Pipers Piping" represent the *eleven* faithful Apostles, not including Judas.

**12<sup>th</sup> Day** - "Twelve Drummers Drumming" represent the *twelve* points of belief in the Apostles' Creed.

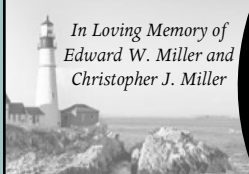
